All the yellow is gone! Everything that I've written has been rewritten and edited. 13,208 words edited and rewritten last month. 122,430 total words rewritten and edited

Everything that is green has a red mark next to it! That means that everything I've written has been run through the grammar checker.

A bunch of the Blue lines are now green. 10,041 new words written this month. 20,225 words added during this editing pass. About 5,000 words to go.

143,421 words are written so far. 3.3% to go.

All good stuff. Sad that I didn't make it to 100%, but I'm a whole lot closer. Most exciting thing is that I've gotten through the two transition parts that were giving me trouble.

Next month, I get to focus on writing the missing parts. With ten chapters to go, at about 500 words each, I should be able to knock one off each evening. Ten more days!

In my off time (driving to and from work mostly) I've continued to think about the artwork. Looks like that will be the focus during the second half of March.

So here's the call. Are you an artist? Do you know someone who is? I'd love to work with people I know to finish this project. What I'm looking for is black and white line art. Here are a couple of examples of the style I'm looking for.
